Opening a new class at Anjali House wasn't a choice. These past years, we focused on the oldest students so they can access higher education and supporting our families through COVID. Our commitment built a strong relationship with 100 families. They rely on our center to enhance their children's education and life skills.

In 2022, there was one request we couldn't ignore, especially after Covid. Many of Anjali parents lost jobs and are now struggling to achieve financial stability again. To obtain a full-time job, they need a proper center to take care of their younger children. Due to the lack of childcare options in Siem Reap, we started to enroll younger students as young as 3 years old. As you can imagine, a 3-year-old who isjust leaving their parents' side for the first time has different needs than a 6-year-old who is learning to read. So, we decided to open a new kindergarten class for these students!

Opening a new class is not a snap. Putting children in a classroom is just the tip of the iceberg. There is a lot of prior work that needs to be done like purchasing equipment, training teachers, tailoring a curriculum, etc. These younger children deserve an equally caring and stimulating environment, as Anjali House already provides to its older students.

We are excited to move forward after being limited in our activities during the pandemic. And to do it, we need you. For the first time in Anjali House history, we are opening a dedicated fundraising campaign for our kindergarten opening: **Spring Up**.
